

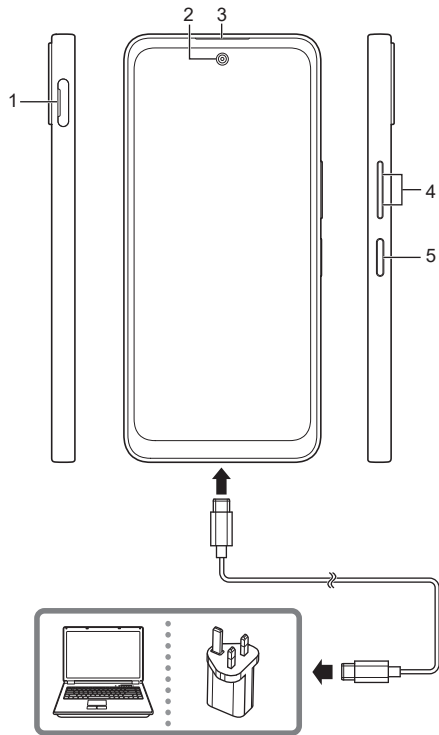
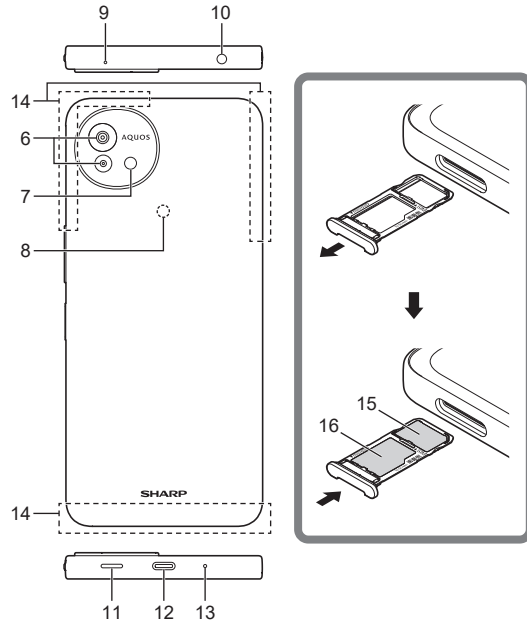

 * It is recommended that you charge the battery for at least 30 minutes before starting up your device for the first time.

Important Information

Please read before proceeding

- The device must have security features to prevent unauthorized persons from manipulating this device by making arbitrary changes to the software.
- The device itself is designed for use in Singapore. If the device is to be used overseas, it may violate the laws and regulations of the destination country, so please check before using. This device supports roaming in the Singapore band and throughout Asia, but please check the information issued by the respective telecommunications carriers regarding roaming charges.
- DO NOT place sharp objects on top of the device, as they may scratch the screen.
- DO NOT drop your device or subject it to severe impacts. Bending the body and pushing the display or keys with extreme force could damage the device.
- DO NOT use a pen or any sharp object to tap the screen.
- DO NOT expose the device to dirty or dusty environments.
- Use this device in the temperature range of 5 °C ~ 35 °C and humidity: 35% ~ 85%.
- Charge device in ambient temperature 5 °C ~ 35 °C; Internal Battery may leak/overheat and performance may deteriorate outside this range.
- DO NOT place the device on an uneven or unstable surface.
- DO NOT insert any foreign objects into the device.
- DO NOT expose the device to strong magnetic or electrical field.
- DO NOT use or store the device in a place where it will be exposed to high temperatures, such as near an open flame or heat-emitting equipment.
- Do not let the product submerged into or get wet with the liquids (seawater, water from a swimming pool, hot water of hot spring, water containing soap, detergent or bath powder, alcohol, soft drink, seasoning, Pet Body Fluids, etc.) other than tap water. If it gets wet, immediately rinse it with tap water.

SAR Information

Your mobile device is a radio transmitter and receiver. It is designed not to exceed the limits for exposure to radio waves recommended by international guidelines. These guidelines were developed by the independent scientific organization ICNIRP and include safety margins designed to assure the protection of all persons, regardless of age and health. The guidelines use a unit of measurement known as the Specific Absorption Rate, or SAR. The SAR limit for mobile devices is 2 W/kg and the highest SAR value for this device when tested at the ear is 0.281 W/kg* and when worn on the body is 0.979 W/kg*. For body-worn operation, this mobile device has been tested and meets the RF exposure guidelines when used with an accessory containing no metal and positioning the handset a minimum of 5 mm from the body. As SAR is measured utilizing the device's highest transmitting power the actual SAR of this device while operating is typically below that indicated above. This is due to automatic changes to the power level of the device to ensure it only uses the minimum level required to reach the network. The World Health Organization has stated that present scientific information does not indicate the need for any special precautions for the use of mobile devices. They note that if you want to reduce your exposure then you can do so by limiting the length of calls or using a hands-free device to keep the mobile phone away from the head.

Warranty Coverage

SHARP provides a Product Warranty Statement for legally authorized SHARP products purchased from SHARP or an authorized reseller. SHARP does not offer a worldwide repair warranty.

If the product fails to function properly under normal environmental conditions, it is covered by a one-year warranty, which is valid from the date of purchase of the device. And is only valid upon presentation of proof of purchase from the date of original purchase.

In the event of natural damage or failure within the Warranty Period that is not covered by the Exclusion of Liability, SHARP will provide you with free "Repair Service", and the Warranty Period for any repaired Machine will be the same as the Warranty Period of the original purchase of the machine. And will not be extended.

For repaired products that have exceeded the warranty period or have been damaged by human error, a three-month warranty is provided for the same problem.
